FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I book my vehicle in with you?

It's very simple. All you do is complete the MOT booking form (which can be found on our website) and follow the step by step instructions. Once you have confirmed your booking you will receive a confirmation email confirming the date, time and location of your booking.

I haven't received a confirmation e-mail yet, what should I do?

We will always try to contact you as soon as you have booked your vehicle in with us. However, sometimes there can be a delay due to the high volume of bookings we take. If you haven't received confirmation by within three hours of your booking please call us on 01753518727 or 01753790065.

What vehicles do you MOT?

We MOT all Class 4 vehicles, including all cars, and vans up to 3500KG weight.

What happens if my vehicle fails it's MOT? Is there a re-test fee?

There is no re-test fee providing the re-test is carried out within 10 working days of the original test. If your car does fail it's MOT, we are more than happy to give you a quote on any repairs that are required. If you choose to have the vehicle repaired elsewhere, the vehicle must brought back for its re-test within 10 working days. If not, a full test will have to be carried out, which will be subject to the standard MOT fee. Re-tests cannot be booked online.

How long does it take to carry out an MOT?

A full test usually takes between 40-60 minutes, but can sometimes take longer depending on the condition of your vehicle. However, we do ask that you can leave your vehicle with us for up to 3 hours.

How often do I need to have an MOT? When do I know when it is due?

If your vehicle is less than three years old, you are not required to have your vehicle tested until the third anniversary of your cars registration, Information of which can be found inside your V5 document(logbook).

You are then legally required to have your vehicle MOT'd every year, however in some circumstances you may have to your vehicle tested more frequently(for more information on this, please visit;
