Removal goods	<p>Foreigners:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Original passport with 12 months visa for both husband and wife.</li> <li>• If client is not married a statement to this effect must be obtained from the Embassy concerned in Jakarta.</li> <li>• Original residence permit (KIMS/card) valid for 12 months, from both husband and wife.</li> <li>• Work permit valid for 12 months.</li> <li>• Packing list.</li> <li>• Original B/L or Airway-bill.</li> </ul> <p>Indonesians:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Original passport.</li> <li>• Assignment and re-assignment letter.</li> <li>• Original letter from Indonesian Embassy at origin stating original arrival date abroad, the date of return to Indonesia, and that the client is bringing back a shipment of household goods to Indonesia.</li> <li>• Original packing list legalised by the Indonesian Embassy in the country of shipment.</li> <li>• Original B/L or Airway-bill.</li> </ul> <p>Returning Indonesians: Government employees must have spent a minimum of 2 years abroad for shipment to be free of duty. Others (non-government employees) must have spent a minimum of 3 years abroad.</p>	<p>Duty free entry of household goods and personal effects is allowed only under the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Only 2 consignments are permitted viz. 1 by sea, 1 by air.</li> <li>• Arrival of the shipment(s) in Indonesia must be within 6 months of the date of issuance on the residence permit (KIMS/ card).</li> <li>• The importer must have used all items for a period of not less than 12 months prior to entry into Indonesia.</li> </ul>

New furniture and household goods		Subject to payment of customs duty.	
Motor vehicles		No entry permitted except duty free for diplomatic personnel.	
Pets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Import permit.</b></li> <li>Health certificate issued within 5 days of arrival in Indonesia.</li> <li>Current rabies vaccination certificate issued at least 30 days before arrival in Indonesia <b>but not older than 1 year.</b></li> <li><b>Quarantine documents from the country of origin.</b></li> </ul>	<p>Subject to payment of import duty.</p> <p><b>The import permit must be issued prior to the animals' arrival into Indonesia. Application for import permit should be made 2 weeks prior to arrival. Following information are needed to process the import permit:</b></p> <p><b>Breed, sex, age, colour and pet's name;</b>  <b>Address in Indonesia.</b>  <b>Arrival date.</b>  <b>Name of owner.</b>  <b>Copy of owner's passport.</b>  <b>Copy of vaccination book.</b>  <b>Copy of health certificate.</b></p>
