6	<b>Vinho Verde, Casa Mendes, Portugal</b> This is a crisp light, fresh and delicate wine with an off dry palate and refreshing acidity with the typical spritz on the palate. 7	<b>Sancerre, La Chenaye Marcel Martin, Loire France 2012</b> A crisp aromatic dry white wine produced exclusively from the Sauvignon Blanc grape with a distinctive floral aroma. Fresh on the attack, really fleshy and full-bodied with typical Sauvignon characteristics.			<b>£36.95</b>
8	<b>Chablis Premier Cru, La Motte Beauroy 2010</b> La Motte's wine is rich and rounded with hints of grilled almonds, gentle toasty oak, buttery fruit then classic mineral tones and acidity balancing on the finish.			<b>£38.95</b>
9	<b>Pernand Verglesses, Vallet Freres, Burgundy, 2011</b> A beautiful and complex wine that packs a big punch above its appellation. A stunning Burgundy with rich and complex aromas of hazelnuts and honey. Fantastic length. Lovely smooth and buttery texture.			<b>£49.95</b>

### Fizz

- 10 Nua Prosecco, Italy NV £6.95 per 125ml flute £26.95**  
A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach. Fresh, softly sparkling palate with characters of soft ripe stone fruits.
- 11 Cremant de Loire Rosé Sauvion NV £7.25 per 125ml flute £28.95**  
The subtle pink colour and delicate strings of bubbles are particularly attractive. On the nose, light aromas of red berries, especially fresh raspberries, encourage further tasting. The palate confirms these impressions with a particularly pleasant sensation of tangy raspberries.
- 12 Champagne Perriet Jouet Grand Brut, France NV £54.95**  
An attractive bouquet with youthful, delicate floral hints. Lovely persistent bubbles with soft and creamy fruit flavours and a lingering finish. Elegant and beautifully balanced.

### Rosé Wines

- 13 Rosé de Syrah Bellefontaine, Pays d'Oc 2012 £6.50 £6.95 £19.50**  
An easy to drink rosé with an orangery pink hue. The wine has a slightly smoky nose which reveals the perfumed spice of Syrah. On the palate the wine shows lovely fresh fruit, notably redcurrant, raspberry and blackcurrant and it has a dry, crisp finish.
- 14 Kenton Rosé 2013 £7.25 £8.25 £23.95**  
Produced from Pinot Noir Early and Rondo grapes. A beautiful vibrant pink colour with aromatic nose and juicy fruit on the palate followed by a surprisingly dry finish.
- 15 Chateau d'Ollières, Rosé de Provence, France 2012 £32.95**  
Deceptively pale, the nose is full of crushed summer fruits whilst the palate is a mouth watering blend of strawberries and redcurrants allied to a creamy texture. Considerable weight and a long crisp finish.

|           | Juicy red fruit packed with subtle brambles and blackberries. Fresh and elegant on the palate with a beautifully delicate structure.   |              |              |               |
| <b>18</b> | <b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Pugilist, Oz. 2013</b>  | <b>£6.95</b> | <b>£7.50</b> | <b>£21.95</b> |
|           | A stunning Cabernet from the Limestone Coast. This rich well rounded wine is oozing with blackcurrant. A dark soft finish which lingers on.  |              |              |               |
| <b>19</b> | <b>Shiraz, False Bay, South Africa 2012</b>  |              |              | <b>£26.95</b> |
|           | A supple and well balanced wine. Dark garnet in colour. Full yet elegant with flavours of juicy red berries and spice. Great length with soft juicy tannins on the finish.   |              |              |               |
| <b>20</b> | <b>Pinot Noir, Sherwood Estate, New Zealand 2012</b>   |              |              | <b>£28.95</b> |
|           | A bouquet of violet laced red berry fruit overlaid with nuances of spice and mocha. A subtle palate of silky smooth raspberry follows through to a lengthy, delightful, typically scented finish.  |              |              |               |
| <b>21</b> | <b>Côtes du Rhône, Domaine Chapoton, Rhone Valley 2012</b>   |              |              | <b>£30.95</b> |
|           | A beautiful blend of Roussane, Marsanne & Viognier grapes. Aromas of violets and soft black fruits dominate and silky ripe tannins lubricate the transition in the mouth.  |              |              |               |
| <b>22</b> | <b>Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Navajas, Spain 2010</b>  |              |              | <b>£33.95</b> |
|           | Matured in American oak for up to 18 months, with up to a further 3 months in bottle. Ruby red colour with light tawny shades, displaying its usual combination of agreeable cherry-like fruit fused with pleasingly toasted vanilla.  |              |              |               |
| <b>23</b> | <b>Anakenna Carmenère, Cachapoal Valley, Chile 2012</b>  |              |              | <b>£35.95</b> |
|           | This carmenère stands out with a deep purple red colour and aromas of plum, black pepper and tobacco which merge with earthy herbaceous notes. On the palate it is a silky, luscious wine with longevity.  |              |              |               |
| <b>24</b> | <b>Malbec, Felino, Vina Cobos, Argentina 2012</b>  |              |              | <b>£38.95</b> |
|           | Deep crimson hued and fragrant with ripe raspberry, cocoa and anise, this is a weighty, richly textured Malbec. A velvety palate with red and black fruits, supple tannins and a lengthy finish.   |              |              |               |
| <b>25</b> | <b>Gevrey Chambertin, Clos de la Justice, Burgundy 2009</b>  |              |              | <b>£59.95</b> |
|           | Clos de la Justice is one of the flagship vineyards owned by Vallet Frères, and has been in the family for nearly 100 years. This stunning example of Pinot Noir displays characters of Girolle cherry alongside rustic notes that express the terroir. The Burgundies this estate produces are complex, fine and taste of the old fashioned, “real” Pinot Noir that their provenance would suggest. |              |              |               |
