

Privacy Policy

Interpretation and Definitions:

Interpretation:

Terms with initial capitalization have meanings as defined herein. These definitions remain consistent whether expressed in singular or plural form.

Definitions:

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- “Account” refers to a unique account created to access our service.
- “Affiliate” pertains to an entity controlling, controlled by, or under common control with us, where control means ownership of 50% or more of shares, equity interest, or other voting securities.
- “Company” (referred to as “the Company,” “We,” “Us,” or “Our” herein) represents Caravan Medic, North East & North Yorkshire.
- “Cookies” are small files placed on your device by a website, storing details of your browsing history among other uses.
- “Country” refers to the United Kingdom.
- “Device” denotes any device capable of accessing the service, such as a computer, cellphone, or digital tablet.
- “Personal Data” comprises any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual.
- “Service” refers to the website.
- “Service Provider” denotes any natural or legal person processing data on behalf of the Company.
- “Usage Data” pertains to data collected automatically, either generated by your use of the service or from the service’s infrastructure itself.
