

## Burnham, Berrow & Brean Code of Conduct

#### **Netting and Longlining**

- ⇒ No netting of any kind (for commercial or recreational purposes) is permitted.
- $\Rightarrow$  No longlines (for commercial or recreational purposes) are permitted.

#### **Recreational Angling**

- ⇒ Make sure you are aware of and adhere to minimum sizes and non-retention species that apply in the Devon and Severn IFCA district (see website details below).
- $\Rightarrow$  Be aware that angling clubs often have larger minimum sizes that you may wish to adhere to.
- $\Rightarrow$  Handle all fish carefully particularly those you intend to return to the sea alive.

#### Monitoring

- ⇒ From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2015 a monitoring programme will be put in place to assess potential benefits of the Angling Zone.
- ⇒ To support the data collection, anglers using the site are encouraged to engage with IFCA officers and spread awareness of the Angling Zone amongst fellow anglers and encourage adoption of the code of conduct.
