

Netting, Longlining and Potting

- No netting of any kind (for commercial or \Rightarrow recreational purposes) is permitted.
- No longlines (for commercial or recreational \Rightarrow purposes) are permitted.
- No potting of any kind is permitted. \Rightarrow

Recreational Angling

- Make sure you are aware of and adhere to minimum sizes and non-retention species that apply in the Devon and Severn IFCA district (see website details below).
- Be aware that angling clubs often have larger \Rightarrow minimum sizes that you may wish to adhere to
- Handle all fish carefully particularly those you \Rightarrow intend to return to the sea alive.
