

Prohibition of Netting – River Exe (19th September 1998)

No person shall fish for or take any sea fish other than by rod and line in any tidal waters that lie between St James' Weir and a straight line bearing 225° true drawn from Retreat House (Topsham) across the River Exe to the opposite shore.

The foregoing does not prohibit the use of a landing net when being used as an auxiliary to angling with rod and line.

For the purpose of this Byelaw "sea fish" means fish of any description found in the sea including shellfish but does not include:-

- a) fish of the salmon species,
- b) trout which migrate to and from the sea,
- c) eels (*anguilla anguilla*)
