

Byelaw Prohibiting Netting in Tamar, Plym and Yealm (15th March 1990)

Notwithstanding Byelaw No. 17 no net shall be used for taking fish in any tidal waters inshore of the closing lines specified herein.

1. River Tamar (and its subsidiary estuaries)

All tidal waters inside a line drawn from Devil's Point 225° True to Wilderness Point.

2. River Plym

All tidal waters inside a line drawn from the western End of Mountbatten Pier 000° True to Fisheries Nose.

3. River Yealm

All tidal waters inside a line drawn 203° True from Season Point to Mouthstone Point,

Provided that this Byelaw shall not prohibit the use of:-

- (a) fyke nets for taking eels, licensed by the Environment Agency;
- (b) seine nets for taking salmon or sea trout licensed by the Environment Agency,
- (c) landing nets used in conjunction with rod and line.
- (d) seine nets with mesh size no greater than 20mm for taking sand-eels in the area described at 3 above.
