

# Live Wrasse Fishery - A consultation on the Potting Permit Byelaw Permit Conditions

There is an emerging live wrasse fishery within its district. Live wrasse are being caught in pots, transported to Scotland and then used in the salmon farms as cleaner fish to control sea lice by eating them. Live wrasse are caught in pots. All potting activity within the district is managed via the Potting Permit Byelaw. A consultation is now underway and will close on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017. There are 5 proposals being consulted on. Potential changes to the potting permits could impact you? It is important that fishers with a potting permit have their say.
