

Live Wrasse Fishery – D&S IFCA introduces permit conditions to manage the fishery

D&S IFCA has taken the lead and introduced multiple measures to manage the Live Wrasse (pot) Fishery in its District.

Management includes changes to potting permit conditions and also voluntary measures.

Spawning season closure, pot limitation, minimum and maximum sizes and voluntary closed areas are some of the new restrictions:
