

SEA FISHERIES REGULATION ACT 1966

The Committee for the Cornwall Sea Fisheries District in exercise of their powers under Section 5 of the Sea Fisheries Regulation Act 1966 hereby revoke the existing byelaw and make the following new byelaw.

TRAWLING IN PARTS OF DISTRICT

- 1. No person shall use in fishing for sea fish any kind of trawl net within those parts of the Cornwall Sea Fisheries District which lie to the landward side of the straight lines drawn respectively:
 - (a) from The Guthens (50° 00'.97N, 005° 05'.33W) to Pedn-myin (50° 01'.80N, 005° 04'.93W), and
 - (b) from Enys Head (49° 59'.50N, 005° 10'.20W) to the seaward extremity of the Carrick Luz (50° 00'.32N, 005° 07'.97W).
- 2. Provided that this byelaw shall not apply to:
 - (a) any person fishing between the 1st of August and 31st of December in any year, both days inclusive, or
 - (b) any person fishing for scientific purposes, with the written authority in that behalf of the Local Fisheries Committee signed by their Clerk and in accordance with any conditions contained in that authority.
- 3. This byelaw shall come into operation on the confirmation hereof by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs and may be cited as the Cornwall Sea Fisheries District Trawling in Parts of District Byelaw 2011.
