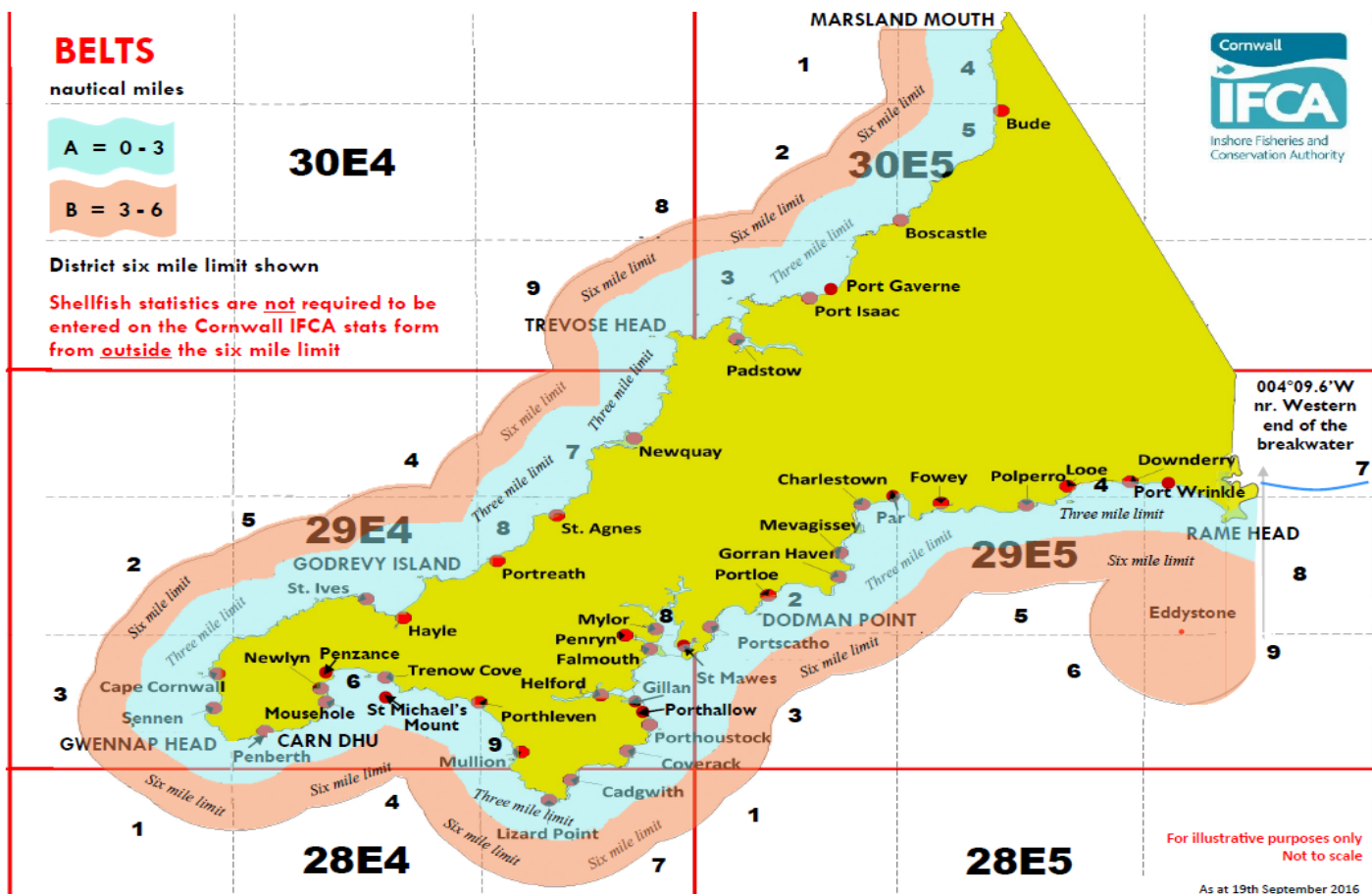

Your data is processed by Cornwall IFCA under a legal obligation conferred in sections 155 and 156 of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009 to process your permit, as is required in the Lobster, Crawfish and Crab Fishing Permit Byelaw 2016. We retain your data for two years following your application for a permit, after which it will be removed and destroyed. Electronic copies also have personal data removed two years after the permit has been issued. **REMINDERS BEFORE SUBMITTING**

- Have you advised the full six-figure area code for the main area fished each day? ICES rectangle, sub-rectangle and belt A or B is required. That is the big red rectangle code, then the smaller sub-rectangle number and then the belt, either A or B. A = 0-3 nautical miles from shore and B = 3-6 nautical miles from shore. E.g. if the main fishing area is within 3nm north of Newquay = 29E47A.
- Cornwall IFCA do not require stats for shellfish caught outside the six mile limit, so do not advise belts C or D on the IFCA stats form.
- Only enter belts A or B on the form – Belt A for the area shaded blue on the District map (or this will appear as the light grey band on black & white copies) or Belt B for the area shaded pink on the map (or this will show as the darker grey band on black & white copies).
- If there was no shellfishing activity at all, or all activity was outside six miles, just tick the nil fishing box on the bottom left of the form. Please note, there is a requirement to submit a monthly return, even if it is a nil.
- On returns that have shellfish activity, have you advised the gear hauled each day?
- Have you estimated in kgs your catch for each species each day?
- Have you signed and dated the form?
- If posting the form, please ensure the correct postage is paid. Underpaid items will not be collected from the Post Office/Sorting Office.
- To save on postage, you can photograph your stats and email them to Cornwall IFCA (please ensure you capture the whole page in the photo, including the OFFICE ONLY section at the bottom) and attach them in an email to enquiries@cornwall-ifca.gov.uk
