Working with Thames Ditton and Weston Green Residents Association (TD&WGRA)

HWRA and TD&WGRA continue to work as independent associations, but the two associations are liaising closely to ensure that the interests of all residents in the new Hinchley Wood and Weston Green Ward are properly looked after. Some changes to the HWRA constitution are needed to take account of the new ward boundaries, and these will be proposed

at the HWRA Autumn General meeting on 13th October.

The three Hinchley Wood and Weston Green ward councillors (see below) are all available to help with issues raised by residents about council services or other local issues.

Community Recycling Centres (CRCs)

Surrey County Council (SCC) have made changes to the operation of their community recycling centres (CRCs), designed to make savings while still maintaining a comprehensive service. Following the introduction of reduced opening hours at some community recycling centres (CRCs) in April, they will be introducing charges for some non-household waste from 1 September. This will include materials such as plasterboard, rubble, soil, turf and tyres.

A leaflet produced by SCC with further information on the charges is available at the CRCs, SCC offices and libraries. Detailed information is also available on the SCC website surreycc.gov.uk/recycling. In addition there will be online advertising and social media activity in the weeks before the charges begin.

Enclosure of some open spaces

Residents may have noticed that posts have been positioned around open spaces in Hinchley Wood and elsewhere in the borough. These are to prevent incursions onto the space enclosed. Posts have not been put in place where there are natural barriers e.g. ditches.
