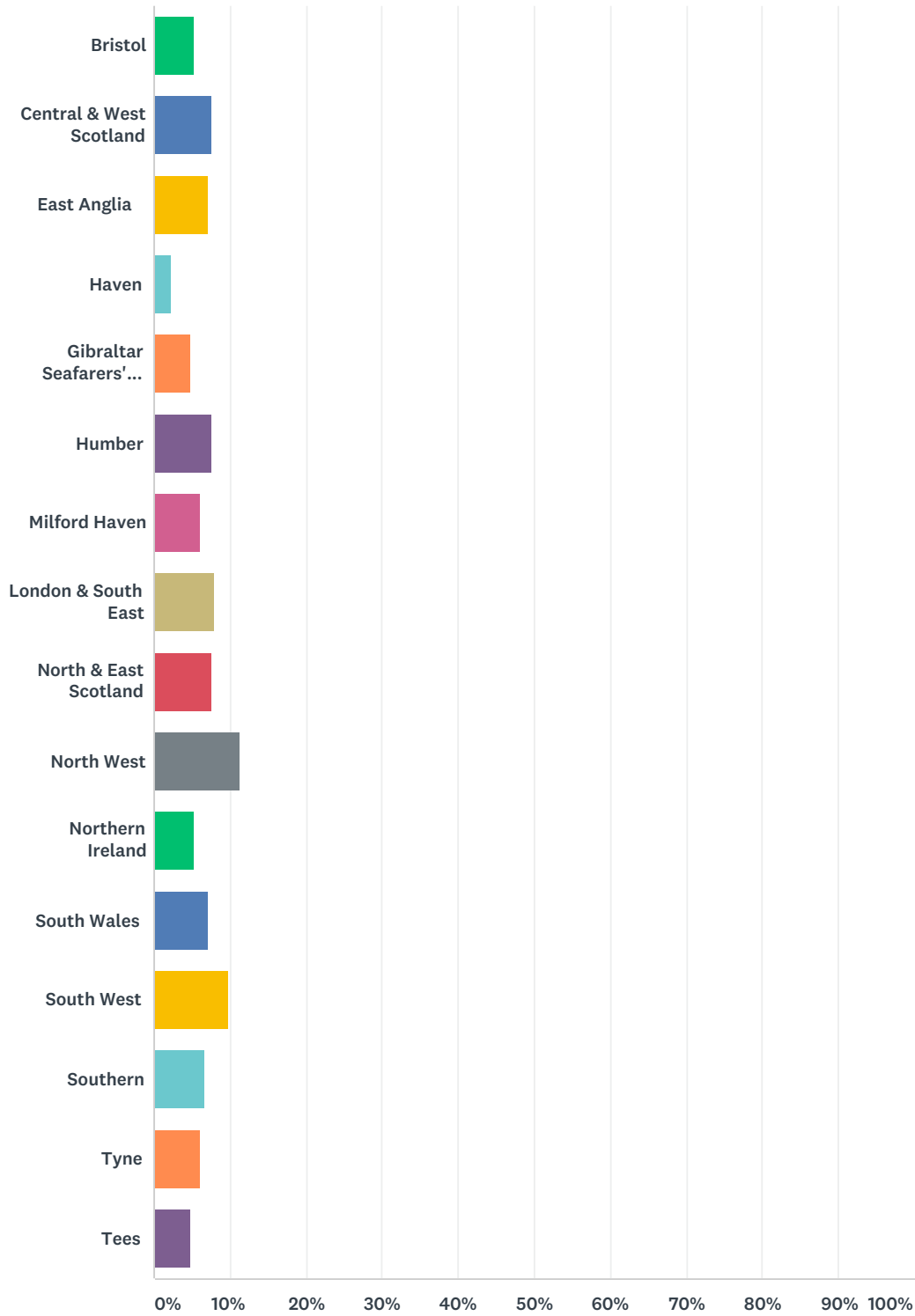

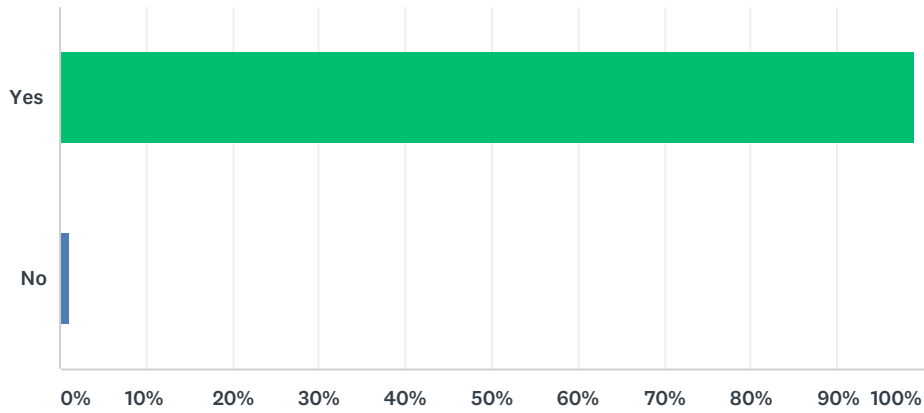

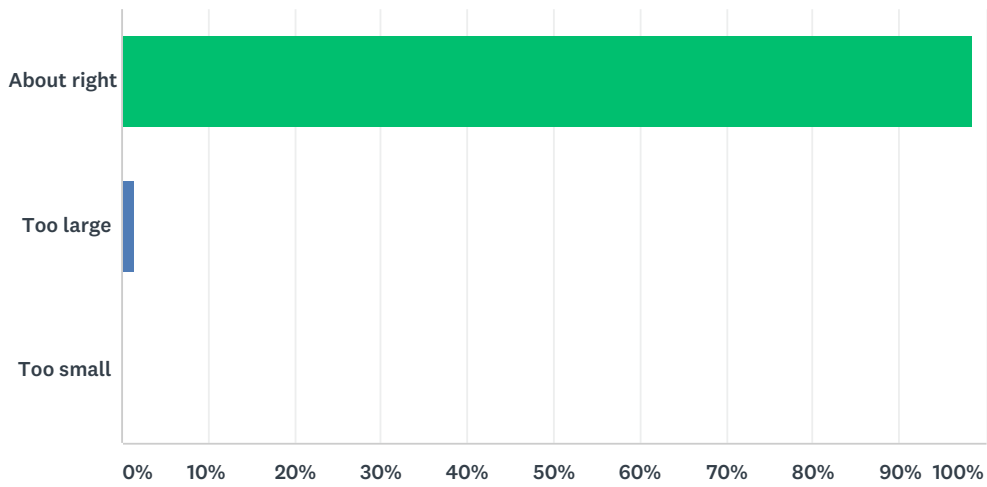

Q5 Which statement do you think best describes the size of the membership of your PWC?

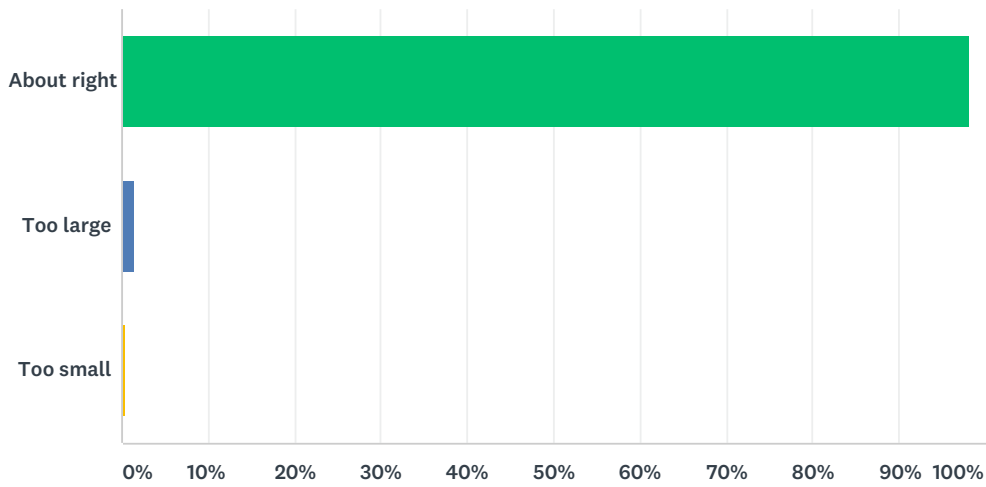

Q6 Which statement best describes the geographical port/s coverage of your PWC?

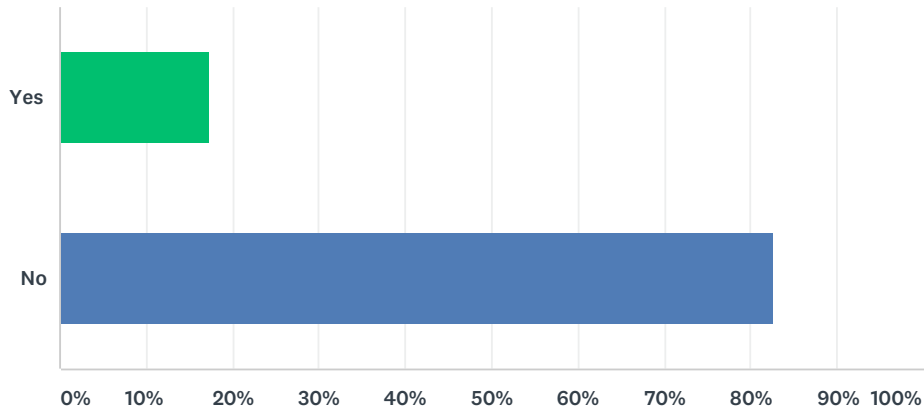

Q7 Are there any other ports or areas in your region that you would like to see join your PWCs?

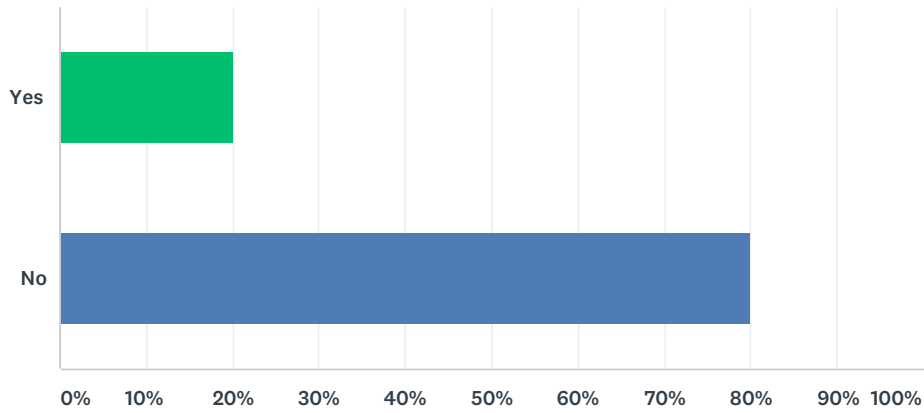

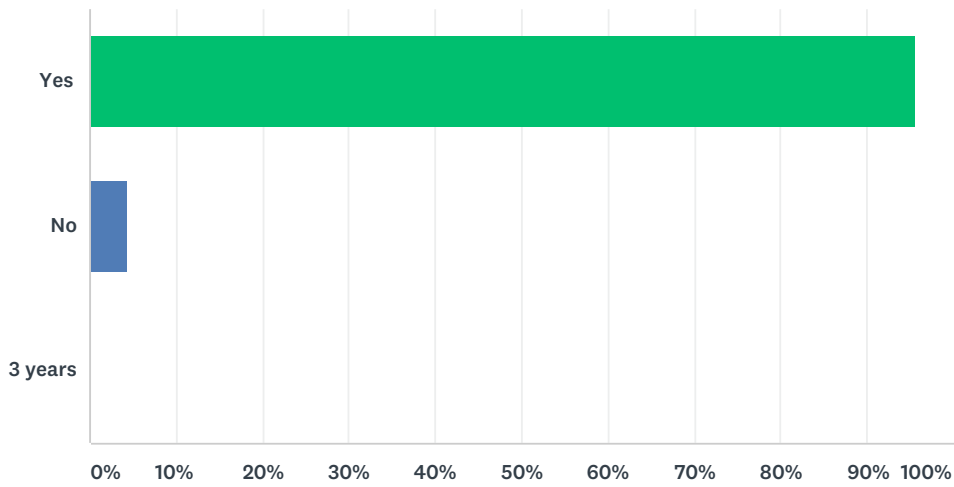

Q9 The Chair & Vice Chair are elected annually. Are you content with this rolling one year term of office?

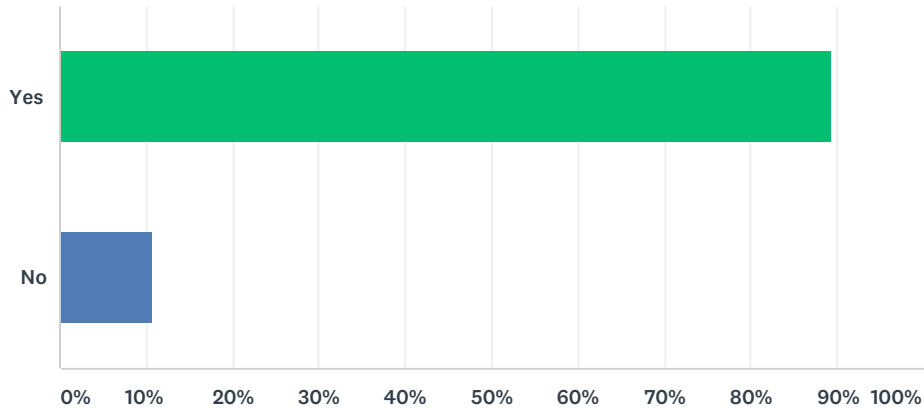

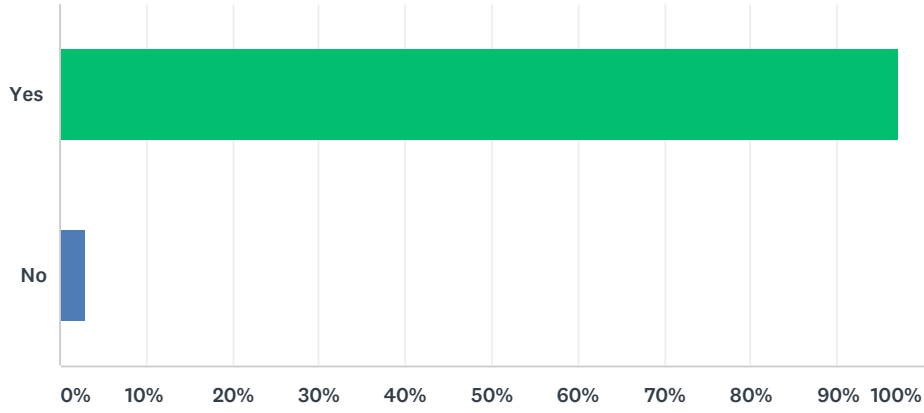

Q11 Are you happy with the existing format and content of your PWC meeting agenda?

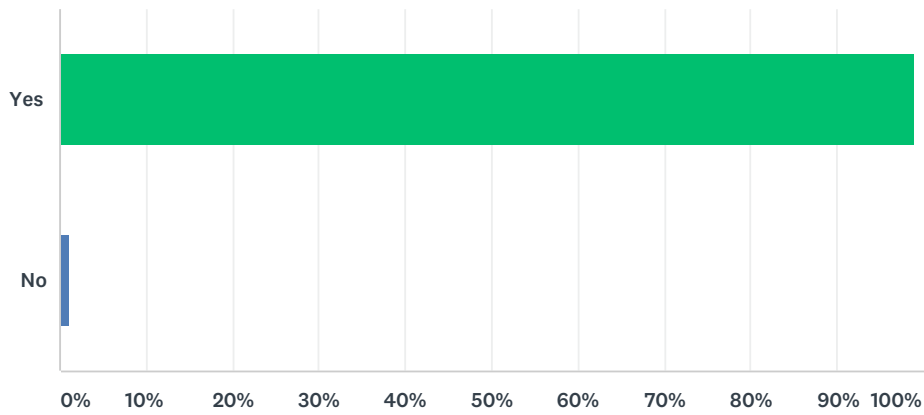

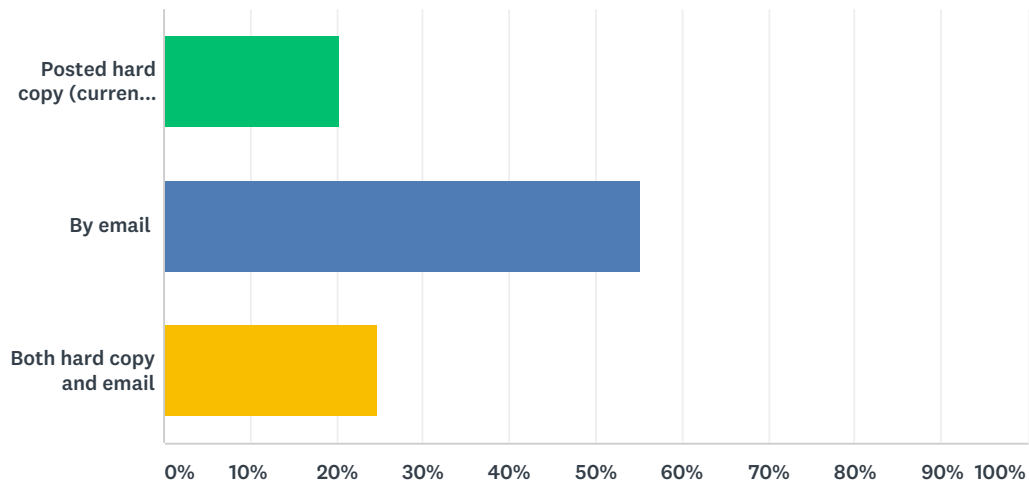

Q13 How do you prefer to receive your pre PWC meeting documentation?

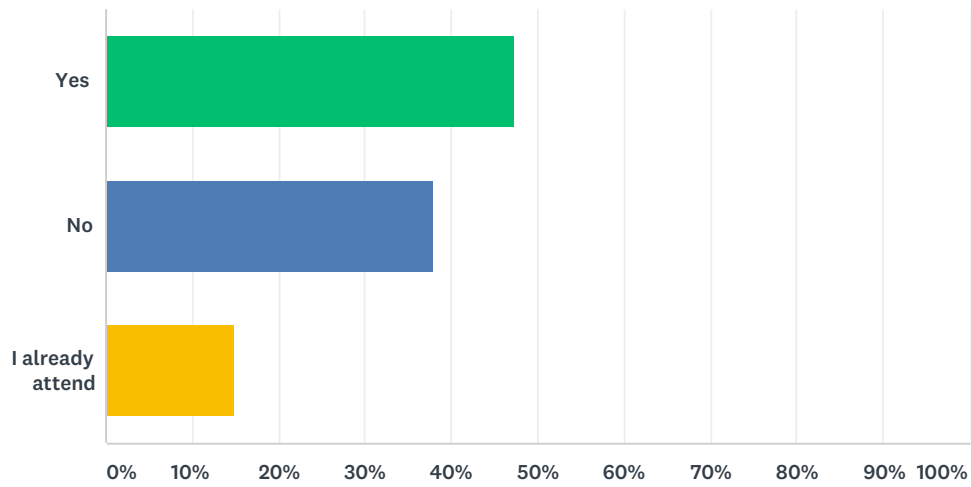

Q14 If invited, would you be interested in attending one of the Boards Annual Conferences?

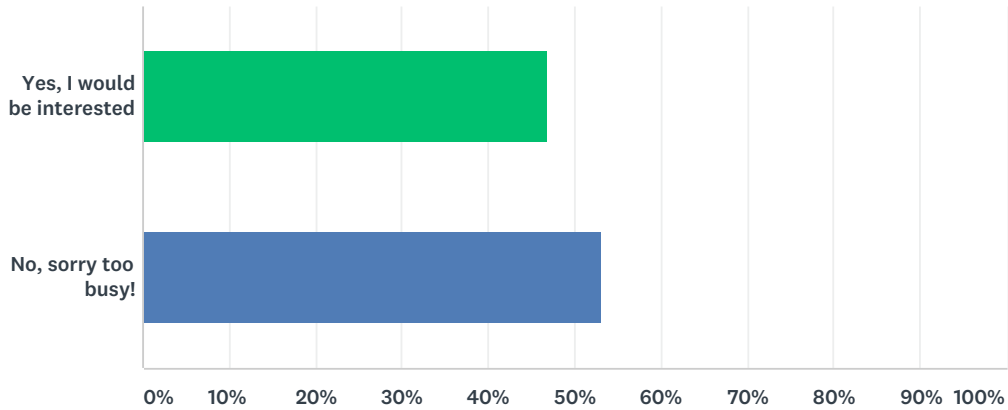
