What data do we hold?

We only hold your name and email address and will never share or pass your information to any 3rd party organisations.

Your Data if you apply to exhibit as an artist or craftsman

If you apply to exhibit at an Art Unequalled event, the application form requests your mailing address, email, website and phone numbers. These are held for the sole purpose of communicating with you for the event and will not be shared with any third parties.

In addition, however, if you are selected to participate in an event, you will be asked for your consent for your email, website and phone number to be published in the show programme to enable visitors to contact you and your website will be published on www.artunequalled.co.uk.

What will we send you?

We will only ever send you information about Art Unequalled, this includes event dates and exciting updates. If you are an artist, this may also include emails on how to apply to exhibit and information you need for the event if you participate.

How to stop hearing from us?

There is an 'Unsubscribe' button at the bottom of newsletters we send. By clicking this button you will be unsubscribed from our mailing list and all communication with Art Unequalled will stop.
