PASS SYSTEM



We are pleased to let you know that open PASS is now available on web, mobile and tablet allowing family members even more flexibility in accessing information about the care.

What's new about openPASS?

OpenPASS 24/7 provides a unique, verified and secure view of real-time care plans and records to authorised users, anywhere anytime and is now supporting real-time care updates for almost 1,000 family members from over 100 care services. Everylife Technologies are introducing a charge for this service. This will now cost £1.99 + VAT per service user, per month. Charges will start from the 1st May 2017.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The openPASS at Home service, which provides an up-to-date view of the care plan and care notes while the end user remains at the service user's address, will continue to be free for 30 minutes at a time, by scanning the QR code on front of the care plan.

If you have any further questions please do not hesitate to contact a member of our team. In the meantime, we hope you continue to find openPASS a valuable new addition to our service.


