

Repeat Prescriptions (registered patients only)

These must be given to reception staff or posted (with a stamped, self-addressed envelope) or faxed. You can also fill in the online form on the website. Please allow 48 hours for processing. Please make sure that, wherever possible, you give us the green form (right hand side of the original prescription) and that you tick the boxes for the medications you require. We do not take requests by telephone. Drugs will be prescribed generically (not using brand names) except in exceptional circumstances.
