



OSCE Preparation for Overseas Nurses

*Our OSCE Preparation Programme is designed to support overseas nurses preparing for the **NMC OSCE**. The course focuses on building confidence, improving clinical and professional communication, and helping candidates understand what examiners are looking for at each OSCE station.*

Who Is This Course For?

This course is suitable for overseas nurses sitting the OSCE for the first time, those who have previously been unsuccessful, and nurses who wish to build confidence in UK clinical practice and communication.

What the Course Covers

The programme includes an overview of the NMC OSCE structure and marking criteria, a breakdown of common OSCE stations, professional communication and documentation standards, time management strategies, infection prevention and control, patient safety, consent, and professional values. Practical tips to reduce anxiety are included, with opportunities for questions and clarification throughout.

- *Small group sessions for interaction and feedback*
- ***Duration: 4 Full Days***
