Dear Parent/Carers,

Broadwaters Extended School Services (BESS) – After school clubs and childcare from April to July 2017

The BESS programme for this term will resume on **Tuesday 2nd May 2017**. The clubs will run until **Friday 14th July 2017 (excluding Monday 29th May - Friday 2nd June 2017 – half term school holiday) a total of ten weeks**. Please use the timetable and forms attached to choose the clubs that you would like your child to attend. There are a **limited number of places** for each activity and they will be offered on a **first come, first serve basis**.

*Parents/Carers who have given the school their email address will be able to book and pay for activities online via MYCHQ. See the attached document for instructions on using the MYCHQ BESS booking system. **50% of the BESS places will be available online via MYCHQ.***

We are **providing our usual interim arrangements of £4 per evening from 3.15-4.30 pm and £9 from 3.15-6.00pm until clubs start**. Please book at reception and pay on the day/in advance. *We cannot take a booking unless payment is received.*

From Monday 24th April we will be accepting **FULL payments with completed forms** (cash only) from 8.20am. In the middle dining hall, and at 3.15pm each afternoon (in Uma's office). We appreciate your patience with queues on these days. We will go live online on **Monday 24th April** for parents that want to book on MYCHQ. Please book clubs at the assigned times so we can ensure fairness in the allocation of spaces.

Please read the attached document carefully as changes have been made. Your child **will not** be allowed to attend a club if full payment has not been received. **Please note that if you owe monies to the school in any form, we cannot accept your form until agreements for payment have been made.**

Please remember to **collect your child promptly at 4.30pm after the club finishes from our reception area** (if you arrive late you may be charged). If your child has been booked into childcare (4:30-6:00pm) they will be taken directly after the club finishes.

We are continuing popular clubs following parent/carer feedback, and have revised those clubs which were less popular. Clubs are changed regularly to ensure difference for regular attendees. **A new club we have introduced is the "I CAN CLUB" and Archery club is back by popular demand.**

Once sessions are booked, your place is secured, and therefore, *we are unable to refund monies paid unless cancelled by us*. This includes missed sessions due to illness, appointments, class trips, children leaving the school etc. for both childcare and clubs. Thank you for your co-operation. **Cheques are no longer accepted for payment**. Payment can be made via Bank transfers and PayPal. **If you're using the queuing system to pay in person, cash ONLY will be accepted.**

After School Club Guidelines

I agree as a parent/carer to pick up my child promptly from the after school club activity at 4.30pm.

I understand that if I do not pick up my child, they shall be placed in the after school club childcare and I shall be charged accordingly (£5 first 15minutes late, £10 thereafter further 15 minutes) which I will be expected to pay on the spot. If unable to do so, I must arrange to pay the fine the next available school day or risk losing my child’s space on the club.

I agree to pay the costs in full of the club before my child starts attending, and understand that refunds will only be given if the school has to cancel the club/activity and cannot allocate the child to another club space (ie swimming). I understand that I am unable to put my child into a club if I have existing monies owed to the school, or if I have not paid in full for the club in advance, or agreed a payment plan.

I understand there will be no refund of monies if my child is unable to attend a club due to an appointment, school trip/activity, or if the child leaves school or has an illness. I understand that once booked, the club space/childcare booking remains in place for the length of the term.

I will inform the school if my child is **not** going to attend an after school club.

I will abide by the Willow home school agreement guidelines for conduct and my child too.

BESS provides afterschool childcare service for parents from 3:15 p.m. to 6:00pm for children from The Willow and Bruce Grove Primary School.

This includes attending a standard club, a light snack and childcare after the club (and if your child attends Bruce Grove Primary School, collection from the school).

Charges are as follows:

Weekly	£45.00
