#### PE Days

PE day for Year 3 classes will be **Tuesday for the first half term** and **Wednesday for the second half term**. Children must bring PE kits to school every PE day. PE kit should be a t-shirt, shorts or track suit bottoms and plimsolls. Please ensure PE kits are washed at least once a half term (during the holidays).

#### **Swimming**

## Spring 1 and 2 2020

## <u>English</u>

This term we will be exploring adventure and mystery stories, looking especially at writing in paragraphs, using conjunctions and adverbial phrases. We will also be following and writing instructions. We are still trying to encourage the children to use neat, joined handwriting. We are also working on improving our spellings.

## <u>Maths</u>

For Maths this term we will be focusing on different measurements; telling the time and reading timetables, measuring length and using decimal notation. We will also be recapping on shapes (including lines of symmetry) and consolidating our four operations (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication).

## <u>Science</u>

Our Science for this term will be: Rocks. The children will be looking at various types of rocks, how they form and how they change.
