<u>Spelling homework will be given out every Monday.</u> Children should practise their spellings for their test the following Monday.


Reading

Autumn 2020

<u>English</u>

Our first unit is **Science Fiction**. We will be revising the key features of fiction genres whilst linking our writing to our science topic on Space. The children will be writing exciting stories with a sci-fi setting.

Later in the half-term, we will be studying our non-fiction unit, **Reports and Explanation.** In this unit we will be focusing on writing reports and using research techniques to help us. After half term, we will be focusing on **Narrative Poetry** and **Persuasive Writing**.

<u>Maths</u>

This year we are using a new maths scheme called White Rose, which encourages the children to apply their mathematical skills in different ways including more of an emphasis on problem solving. This half term we will be focusing on **Number and Place Value.** Children will be learning about the value of digits to one million, multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 as well as focusing on rounding numbers. They will be using all four operations which will be applied to solving a range of word problems. We will then move on to other mathematical areas exploring geometry, fractions and data handling.

<u>PSHE</u>

We are continuing with our One Decision programme. After a very confusing and difficult year so far, we will look back at our lockdown memories and explore emotions. We will then reflect on how we can make the most of the year academic ahead. We aim that all children will be encouraged to make and achieve personal, physical, social and emotional targets to take them a step closer to their long term aspirations.

History/RE

Year 5 are studying a brand new topic this term for History. This topic combines with Religious Education. We will finding out about the history of *Ancient Islamic Civilisations*.

The topic looks at the history of Baghdad. Trading and the Silk Road. It looks at the life of the prophet Mohammed (pbuh), the Arabian Nights story and a study of Arabic art.

<u>Science</u>

In Science we will be learning about **'Earth and Space'** with a focus on the planets, describing the movement of the Earth around the sun and the Moon relative to Earth as well as understanding how we have day and night.

<u>PE</u>

This half term Year 5 are studying *Dance* in the hall with Miss Clunis. We ask that you wear your PE kit to school every *Wednesday*. After the half term holidays we will be having PE lessons with Bradley which will then be on *Thursdays*.
