<u>Literacy</u>

We shall be studying aspects of narrative, such as fiction genres, characters and settings. We will revise grammar objectives from Year 5 as well as introduce some new terminology. In Autumn 2, we will study non-fiction texts, such as biographies and autobiographies. Throughout these units, we will be revising core VCOP skills.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on place value, ordering and rounding numbers, money and word problems and fractions, decimals and percentages We will also be revising our mental arithmetic skills and problem solving.

Science

Our first science unit will be based on living things and their habitats. We will be looking at how animals and plants can be classified into groups as well as studying micro-organisms. In Autumn 2, we will be studying evolution and inheritance. We will be looking at endangered and extinct animals and how animals adapt to their surroundings.

Topic

We will be learning about the history of crime and punishment over different time periods. We will start when the Romans invaded Britain and move onto when the Anglo Saxons and Vikings arrived. The unit will cover whether the rich and poor were treated differently during this times and whether that has been an ongoing issue throughout the ages. Finally, we will develop our own opinions of the systems of law and how it has changed.

Computing

We will be teaching the children how to use google classroom! This is a great tool to submit work and access homelearning. We will be continuing to build children's confidence in Word programmes and using ICT lessons to support research in topic.

PSHE

We will be using our new PSHE scheme '1decision' to look at various scenarios including those linked to bullying, citizenship, safety and relationships. We will also have class discussions each week during circle time.

RE

This term we will be studying Christianity. We will focus on Christian worship, values and festivals.

PE Days

<u>Autumn 1, Spring 1 and Summer 1—Mondays</u> Autumn 2, Spring 2 and Summer 2—Thursdays

This year, your child will need to come to school in their PE kit on their PE day. They will need to have black shorts or tracksuit bottoms, a white T-shirt and trainers. No watches or jewellery are allowed to be worn during the lesson.

Homework

Mathletics and spelling homework will be given out each week using google classroom. Your child may also be given weekly homework using CGP books to help them prepare for SATs. Please encourage and support your child with this learning and ensure they are completing their homework.

Reading

Reading is one of the most important life skills for your child. It is essential that they read to an adult for 15 minutes every day. Children will be given weekly slots to complete their AR tests.
