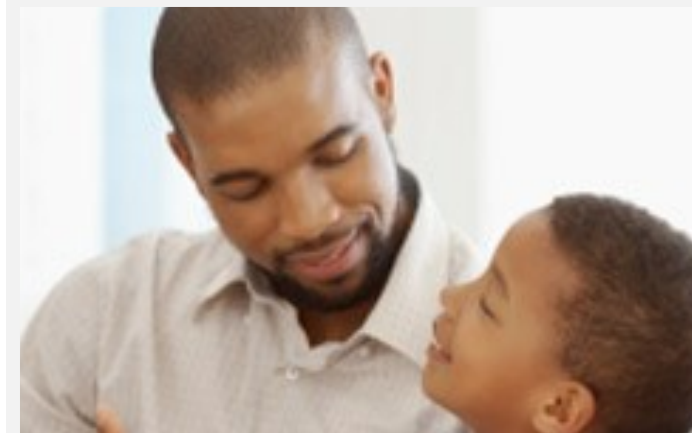

The PARENT/CARER
