Holidays

As you will know, children are expected to be in attendance at school for the whole of each term and the DfE are very clear that in-term holidays cannot be authorised. We certainly find that when children are away from education for a period of time, their progress is affected. There are times, however, when there are family crises and we understand that there may be no extended family to look after your child. If this is the case then it is important that we have at least a week's notice so that we can provide work for your child to do in their absence. If we do not get any request for authorisation then we are obliged to contact the Education Welfare Service when there is an absence for which we do not know the reason.
