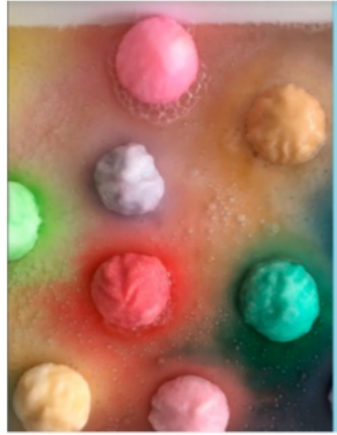


Bubbly balls



You will need:

- Bicarbonate of soda
- Water
- Vinegar
- Ice bucket or something similar
- Food colouring or paint

What to do:

1. Mix bicarbonate of soda with a little water to make a dense ball.
2. Divide the big ball into a few smaller ones and place them in the ice bucket.
3. Then add food colouring or paint to each ball until they are completely covered.
4. Put them in the freezer for a few hours until they are solid.
5. Take the balls out of the bucket and put in a tray.
6. Add a few drops of vinegar to each ball and watch the colours mix together and enjoy the bubbly balls fizzing.
