

Germ blow painting art with straw

Resources

Liquid watercolour paint

Paintbrush

Straws

Thick white paper

Construction paper

Black marker

Glue stick

1. Pour your liquid watercolours into an art palette or paint cups.

Use a paintbrush to add a small puddle of paint onto the paper.



2. Place the straw about an inch away from the puddle. Use the straw to blow the paint blobs around in all directions. Try blowing down directly onto the puddle, blowing from the left and blowing from the right. See how many different shapes you can make with the watercolours.

3. Repeat this step with each of the colors.



Let the paint dry completely (ours took about 15 minutes; if you need these done quick, you can use a blow dryer as well).

4. Cut circles from the white paper and glue them onto the blow paint germs.



5. Use a black marker to draw the eyes onto the germs.



6. Glue the white paper onto a piece of coloured construction paper to finish it off
