

Raining Rainbows



This experiment is so pretty and very easy to set up.

What you need:

A glass contained or a vase

Water

Shaving foam

Food colouring

Spoons or droppers for the coloured water

What to do:

1.Fill the glass container about 2/3 full.

2.Shake the foam and squirt a layer of shaving foam on top of the water in the glass container.

3.Spread it out so it covers all the water.

4.Use a spoon or dropper and drop the coloured water onto the shaving foam. The shaving foam floats on the water but the coloured water will gradually soak through because it is denser than the shaving foam....

5.Watch the rainbows appear. Be sure to look right under the shaving foam cloud, it is so pretty. Very delicate and the colours seep through gently...Even pretty from the top.

6.Wash out the vase so you can try again with a different set of colours.
