What Are We Learning?

We are learning how to compare two groups of objects and noticing when they have the same number in each.

How to Set up the Challenge

- Find as many of your shoes as you can and put them in a pile.
- Choose one person from your family and collect as many of their shoes as you can find.
- Add them to the pile of your shoes.

How to Get Your Child Thinking

- How did you find out who had the most/fewest shoes?
- Were there the same number of shoes? How did you know?
- What helped you to compare the groups of shoes?
- Did you find a way to check how many were in each group?

- Can you sort your shoes into one group and your family member's shoes into another?
- Can you compare the groups of shoes?
- Who has the most shoes?
- Who has the fewest?
- Are there the same number in each?
