

## HOW TO MAKE A PAPER PLATE SUNFLOWER CRAFT

### Resources:

- Paper plate
- Green cardstock paper
- Yellow and black craft paint
- Pencil with eraser
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- Glue



### Instructions:

1. Start by painting the paper plate yellow. You can use a paintbrush or a sponge paintbrush. We love the sponge paintbrush alternative as the kids can paint faster. Or You can choose to start with a yellow paper plate. This way you can skip the painting part in case you're looking to avoid a step that can potentially get messy.

2. Squeeze some black paint on a small paper plate or a plastic container.



3. Let your kid dip the pencil end eraser into the black paint and then press it on the paper plate to make dots.

Repeat this step until the middle of the paper plate is covered in black dots.

These will be the sunflower seeds.



4. Once the paint has dried completely, cut out slits along the paper plate's rim. Use a pencil to draw a stem and one leaf on green paper and cut them both out. Glue the leaf onto the stem. Add the stem to the back of the paper plate.

You have now a beautiful paper plate sunflower. You can glue the entire sunflower onto a sheet of cardstock paper or leave it as is.
