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Planning in Nursery and Pre-School Settings Outdoor / Indoor Learning (All on one plan!)

This is a modular approach to planning for anyone wishing to refresh their nursery or pre-school planning. The sessions will take participants through the process of planning for learning. All sessions will be delivered via Zoom. Each session will include:

- Planning for progression in learning across an area of the curriculum – both indoor and outdoor (no need for separate indoor and outdoor plans)
- Examination of planning documents for preschool (up to age 4). Long-Term, Medium-Term and Short-Term Plans will be examined. **Copies of Long, Medium- & Short-Term planning will be given to participants – corresponding to each session**
- Practical support on how to plan for and extend learning - using evaluations and observations to inform planning for learning
- Focus on high quality learning and suitably challenging experiences that engage children’s minds
- Intentional resources and intentional environments – mostly low cost/no cost resources
