

Privacy Policy, effective date 24th May 2018

This data protection and privacy policy explains who we are, how we process any personal data we hold and your rights relating to the storage and use of your data. It also details how to get in touch with us if you need to.

Who we are

Azure Computers are Computer Brokers dealing exclusively with other brokers and traders worldwide. Our Business Model is solely Business-to-Business; we do not trade with endusers. We take the privacy and security of any personal details held by us very seriously and are committed to protecting this information. Here we outline our Privacy Policy, which sets out how we handle any information we hold about you.

Our contact and other details are set out at the end of this policy.

We operate a single website as follows:

This website does not collect personal data at all. There is no registration process, no user portal or login information and no page or section requiring you to authenticate yourself for use. It is an information only website. We do not use the site to engage in any form of eBusiness and there are no means for any personal information to be recorded or submitted to us through the use of our website.

The purposes for which we collect personal data

Personal Data held by us only comes direct from business transactions between us and individuals employed by the companies we trade with. This is in the form of emails only.

This information enables us to communicate with you in relation to the sale or purchase of goods or services (for example, email address, address, place of work, phone numbers, bank account information and other information relating to you that is included in any communications between us and you in the course of the business transaction).

Any data held cannot be directly associated with the private identity of any particular individual. Neither is this information used to inform or influence actions or decisions affecting an identifiable individual. Data does not have any Biographical significance, nor does it focus or concentrate on the individual as its central theme. Data is held exclusively pursuant to business transactions made between Azure Computers and the company or entity the individual is employed by. This data does not impact or have the potential to impact on an individual, whether in a personal, family, business or professional capacity.

We do not use personal data for marketing purposes.

Where we process your personal data

We process personal data in the UK, EU and Worldwide.



Security of your personal data

All personal data processed by us is stored securely (the level of security being appropriate to the nature of the data concerned and the other relevant circumstances).

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via email uses the Internet; a publicly accessible medium which is therefore, not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect any personal data we receive from you in the form of email, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to us and any email sent is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use all appropriate procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access

Who we share your personal data with

We may where appropriate share your personal data with appropriate third parties including:

Our business partners, customers, suppliers and sub-contractors for the performance of any contract we enter into or other dealings we have in the normal course of business transactions between us and you or the company that you work for;

Our auditors, legal advisors and other professional advisors or service providers;

Credit or other similar reference agencies for the purpose of assessing your suitability or ability where this is in the context of us entering (or proposing to enter) into a contract with you or the person that you work for.

Other disclosures we may make

We may disclose your personal data to third parties:

If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of supply and other agreements with you or the company that you work for; or to protect the rights, property, or safety of our business or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection, or credit risk reduction.

How long we keep your personal data

We process personal data only for so long as is necessary for the purpose(s) for which it was originally collected, after which it will be deleted or archived except to the extent that it is necessary for us to continue to process it for the purpose of compliance with legal obligations to which we are subject or for another legitimate and lawful purpose.

Your rights

You have the following rights in relation to personal data relating to you that we process: You may request access to the personal data concerned.

You may request that incorrect personal data that we are processing be rectified. In certain circumstances (normally where it is no longer necessary for us to continue to process it), you may be entitled to request that we erase the personal data concerned. To exercise any of your rights (including withdrawing relevant consents or obtaining access to your personal data), you should contact us as set out below.



If you have a complaint about any processing of your personal data being conducted by us, you can contact us or lodge a formal complaint with the Information Commissioner.

Contacting the regulator

The Information Commissioner is the supervisory authority in the UK and can provide further information about your rights and our obligations in relation to your personal data, as well as deal with any complaints that you have about our processing of your personal data.
