

COVID-19 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Following the governments relaxation of the restrictions we will be re opening from the 1st June. We are able to take some bookings in a restricted manner for 1/2hr privates and competent group lessons of 3 in order to still conform to national requirements in order to protect clients and staff.

We can only take bookings from competent riders and therefore there will be no beginner lessons at the moment, along with no jumping or riding without stirrups at the present time.

All riders must be able to mount on their own, do their own girth and stirrups and have their own equipment, including a hat, clean gloves and a whip. Gloves must be worn at all times and freshly cleaned clothes to every lesson. Parents accompanying any child must also wear gloves at all times.

We also request that only 1 person from the same household accompanies a child for a private lesson and adults must come alone.

A 15 minute gap will be left between lessons to ensure as few people as possible are on the yard. At this current time we may not be able to give people a permanent weekly time as we can only do a limited number of clients per day, so please be patient as we will be working on a week to week basis.

The toilet and office/tack room will be out of use.

All lessons must be paid in advance by BACS.

Please keep 2m apart from everyone on the yard.

Tack will be cleaned after every use.

All lessons will be in the outdoor school.

Clients will need to wait in the car until a member of staff comes to collect you and then you can make your way to the outdoor school with your horse.

By booking a lesson you must read AND accept these conditions.

We apologise that it is not business as usual but we must conform to government regulations and do everything possible to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
