## Winter Tips

- To help reduce condensation, try as best as possible to maintain an even temperature within the property, opening internal doors to allow the heat to circulate and using draught excluders where necessary.
- Turn off any outdoor water supplies to reduce the risk of the pipes bursting.
- Ensure everyone in the house knows where the electricity and water supply is in the event that it needs to be turned off/on.
- Have the Pentland Housing Association emergency contact number handy, just in case.
- To stay nice and warm during the colder months, its better to wear multiple thin layers rather than one thicker layer.
- Have a box of essentials, such as blankets, torches and candles prepared in case of any power cuts.
- Watch your footing when walking on icy surfaces—use salt or sand to defrost this NOT water as this may re-freeze and turn to black ice.
- Secure or store any garden furniture or outdoor toys to avoid them being damaged or blown away.
