This privacy policy sets out how I (Audrey Bossman – The FlameWithin) use and protect any information that you give me..

I do not share, or sell, or disclose to a third party, any personally identifiable information collected.

Here is a list of the information I collect, and why it is necessary to collect it:

Name and basic contact details, including email address

This information is used:

- · to provide you with the services which you request
- to maintain my accounts
- to enable me to answer your enquiries
- for marketing my services and products

What I do with the Information Gathered

I require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping
- I may use the information to improve my products and services
- I may periodically send promotional emails and newsletters notifying you about new products, special offers or other information which I think you may find interesting, using the email address which you have provided
- Disclosure to Government I may be required to give information to legal authorities if they so request, or if they have the proper authorisation such as a search warrant or court order

I hold on to your personal information for as long as is necessary for the purpose(s) for which it was collected, unless otherwise required by law. Client records are held for five years from the date of your last contact with me and your information is kept secure whether held online (see below) or on paper, in which case it is kept in a locked cabinet. If you request that I stop sending you updates and other communications or delete your information, I will honour your request and keep the minimum amount of information possible to prevent fraud and to help ensure that you are not contacted again.

Security

I am committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, I have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information collected online.

Where you have chosen a password which enables you to access certain parts of my website, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. I ask you not to share your password with anyone.

How I Use Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

I use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps analyse data about web page traffic and improve my website in order to tailor it to customer needs. I only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help me provide you with a better website, by enabling me to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with me.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
