

Entry requirements

1. Academic achievement

- A typical student would have the equivalent of the British A-levels. The minimum requirement is ABB.
- Local national curricula: this corresponds to an average grade of 80% as well as 70%+ in subject specifics => check our website
- **IB Diploma:** the minimum scores vary between 35 and 38 according to the degree chosen.
- For some of our degrees we will also need to look at the subject specifics/HL levels you have taken before.

2. Outside of school

As well as your academic achievements, we will look at:

- Your proficiency in English (TOEFL, IELTS, Duolingo tests...);
- Your engagement in past or present extracurricular activities (sports, civic engagement, cultural interests, community service, for instance);
- Your motivation for joining Forward College.
