

Fees, passports & residency

Access to Universities

- UK / Ireland Common Travel Area means no change
- For other nationalities, the same rules apply, but UK students are now treated as non-EU

Finance Implications

- Some universities treat EU and non-EU the same for fees (Germany, Flanders, private universities)
- Difference between passport and residency in some countries
- Difference for non-EU is not just higher fees, but also access to government finance


