**Qualification for Ordinary Membership (Articles of Association clause 15)*

Ordinary Membership shall (subject to articles 18, 20 and 22) be open to any person aged 17 or over who:

- is ordinarily resident in the Community (defined in article 4 as “the Community of North Mull which comprises the postcode districts PA72, PA73, PA74 and PA75); and*
- is entitled to vote at a local government election in a polling district that includes the Community or part of it*
