Road closures: April, & June

RPC raised with the City Council the very late notice of an *imminent* **High Street road closure for Thursday 6th and Friday 7th April.**

A new gas connection for a property in Rottingdean High Street, means a closure for completing the works **overnight on 15th June 2017.** The works are planned to take one night.



The Dene waste bin was raised by a resident as needing reinstatement to its former home behind The Dene now that building works are complete.

Southern water is offering presentations to Community Groups as part its FOG (Fat, Oil & Grease) & 'Unflushables' project designed to engage and educate customers on what not to put down drains and toilets, and the issues that can arise if people flush items such as sanitary products and wet wipes, along with fat, oil & grease.
