HGVs using the B2123 through Rottingdean:

Many will have read the article in Rottingdean Village News asking residents to support the Police in efforts to bring this under control. Police have stopped several vehicles, the largest being 40 tonnes. Traffic Offence Reports were issued leading to fixed penalty notices to those that contravened the 7.5 tonne weight limit that were NOT delivering to Rottingdean shops/pubs.

The East Prevention team has also been in the High Street recording details of vehicles which cut through and then have contacted the offending companies' directors asking them to take responsibility for their drivers who continue to ignore the road regulations.

PCSO Zack Price is leaving his post in June to begin training as a PC and his replacement is as yet unknown, he has asked that when you are out and about in the Village, if you see an HGV please can you take a photo of the registration number, name of company and send the information, together with the time and date etc to brightonandhove@sussex.pnn.police.uk as a central place to contact. On emails just put '**East Prevention HGV's**'. This way it will be forwarded to the correct office to be actioned.
