Locations & signage for Bike share hub in Rottingdean

BHCC has shared a proposed Scheme layout and signage including designing potential new printed surface signs for the Undercliff which could be applied to the footway surface, and in keeping with wider road safety messages used across the City.

The current Scheme proposes 4 new signs, 3 of which to be printed on the ground. The message:

'Share the Space, Drop the Pace'

is consistent with current campaigns to persuade all users about safe & effective use of available public highways.

The preferred location for the Bikeshare Hub, the operator **Hourbike** prefers a site adjacent to the White Horse pub, as this is likely to generate the highest number of users. Local councillors are in correspondence with BHCC to ensure the interests of pedestrians especially children are fully considered.
