



## Parish Notes – 5 March 2018

**Pavements in Rottingdean Conservation Area:** distinctive characteristics in the Conservation area include the paving – individual red pavier bricks rather than tarmac.

A number of the bricks are loose and /or broken. RPC has requested these are repaired or replaced like-for-like where necessary.

Where older 'pitted' bricks have been replaced with modern smooth-topped ones, these can become slippery in wet weather. A coating of clear anti-slip resin is thought to alleviate this problem and reduce the likelihood of the City Council facing claims in the event of slips and falls. **Traffic Regulation Order:** consultation ended on 2 March to extend DYs in Court Ord Rd.

**Hidden Valley Flying Park closure:** Notice has been issued of the closure of the business which cannot afford to commercially operate without planning permission from the SDNPA

**Banks:** The Rottingdean branch of Lloyds bank closed on 1 March 2018. NatWest branch in Peacehaven closes on 12 June 2018.
