# Neighbourhood Plan

Rottingdean Parish has been given the go-ahead to develop a Neighbourhood Development Plan. This will add weight to planning and development policies adopted by the village via a local Referendum. We hope that to hold the Referendum this year.

We carried out Focus Groups, meetings and a Village Survey in 2013 before drawing up the draft vision for the village and testing priorities for the Plan.

The questionnaire was publicised via a card delivery to all households in the Parish, i.e. 1560 addresses. The questionnaire was available electronically via a link from Rottingdean Parish Council website www.rottingdean-pc.gov.uk to Brighton & Hove City Council website where it was hosted. Paper copies were made available to those either unwilling or unable to complete the questionnaire on-line.

The questionnaire was directed at residents, those working or studying in the village or visiting regularly for other reasons. The survey period was from Saturday 3 August to Friday 27th September to encourage maximum participation. A total of 181 completed questionnaires were returned; 153 of these were electronic returns and 22 were on paper.

Results were collated by Brighton & Hove's Environment Initiatives Team and presented at a meeting of Rottingdean Parish Council on 7 October. These findings will help to inform the development of our Parish Neighbourhood Plan. Many thanks to all those who took the time to complete the survey.
