



Special Arrangements for attendance at the Rottingdean Parish Council Meetings

In view of the current social distancing measures, Rottingdean Parish Council Meetings will take place by video/audio link until further notice.

Within this constraint the Parish Council wish to run the meeting as close as possible to the established process. Members of the public will be able to view the proceedings by video and audio link and there will be an opportunity at the beginning of the meeting for people to speak for 3 minutes in line with the current arrangements.

In order to join the meeting **you will need to register your interest in advance** by completing the attached registration form.

- You will be sent email confirmation that your registration has been received.
- On the morning of the meeting you will be emailed an invitation to the meeting that will include a link and the password.
- **At the time of the meeting** just click on the meeting link follow the instructions on screen and you will join the meeting.
- If the host has not yet joined you will be asked to wait to be admitted to the meeting.
