4	<p>Bowling Green grass; To prevent vehicles being parked on grass Rob Walker has agreed for 20 stones to be placed near road. To be discussed and agreed with Chair of Bowling Club.</p>
5	<p>Pond: Request for better walkway by Plough pub and disabled/pushchair access. Possible yellow hatching by road to prevent cars parking by entrance.</p> <p>Crayfish have been eliminated.</p> <p>Pete The Pond to perform maintenance work on the island and submit invoice</p>
6	<p>Drain on Chailey Ave; Gets blocked and causes flooding in St. Margaret's School and Whiteways Lane. Caused by topsoil coming off the fields above.</p>
