Discussion Items/Briefing notes	
1	The potential for a beacon is undecided and we await a decision by BHCC. If an agreement is reached with the British Legion RPC will assist in order to mitigate impact on the nature reserve
2	The grazing has been completed but NEAG wish to check that FOBH were involved in consultation before the sheep were moved as agreed
3	Section 106 submissions. Further discussions, on disability access, has developed a concept. The pond has been designed and contact made with officials and a meeting has taken place on the Beacon. The pond proposal appears not to be progressing. Beacon Hub will meet to consider how the disability access could be progressed
4	<p>A meeting has taken place with the contractor who is sourcing the slabs. The disabled parking has been installed. The railings have been repaired but they are in a poor state and consideration is being given to more restoration. A site visit with a contractor has been made and a quote is awaited. The contractor is not responding to requests and further quotes are to be sought</p> <p>Quotes have been received for a system that would introduce a wider variety of planting around the pond. The quotations are in the region of £100 and further quotes are being obtained</p>
5	The concerns about the stability of the cliff face have been followed up and a reply received from Toni Manuel. She is seeking the engineers report
6	The damaged coping slabs on the Terraces have been reported and made safe. Toni Manuel is following up and a contractor will be appointed to replace. Rottingdean Arts will be repainting the Terraces and fixing the door
