What are cookies?

Cookies are small files that are stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone by the websites that you visit. Website owners use them to help make websites work more effectively and enhance website functionality. We use cookies to help you move around the site, for example by keeping a track of the pages that you visit.

Cookies help you get the best out of our website, but you can disable cookies. You will still be able to use our website if you do this, but you may lose some functionality.

Managing cookies

You can change browser settings to stop websites storing cookies on your computer, tablet or smartphone. You can also change your settings so that a pop-up warning appears before cookies are stored. As mentioned above, changing your cookie settings may change the functionality of our website.

You'll need to change cookie settings for each browser and device that you use. The procedure for changing settings varies depending on the browser you use: the browser help function will explain what to do.
