Statistics

- 22% of children in Europe feel that **pornography** upsets them most, followed closely by **violent content (18%)**.
- 75% of 12 to 15-year-olds has a social media profile.
- 1 in 3 internet users are children.
- Nearly 1 in 8 young people have been bullied on social media.
- Almost 25% of young people have come across **racist or hate messages** online.

“I spend about 12 hours online every day”

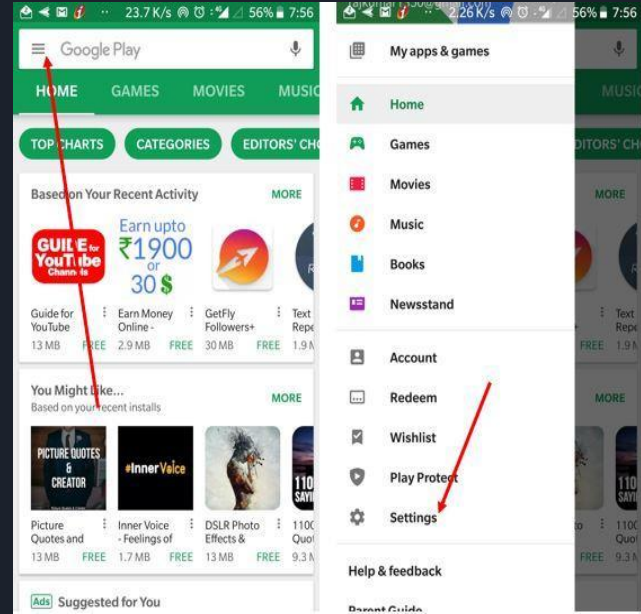
“I don’t like reading inappropriate jokes, especially about me or my friends”
