POLICE INITIAL ACTIONS		
Missing	Exploited	Trafficked
Take Missing Person report and take steps to locate MISPER	Where offences exist, deal with offences	Unaccompanied young person from abroad – photos and fingerprints are taken; Police gather SIM card, mobile and belongings Trafficking investigation instigated where offences exist

If immediate concerns – always report to Police on 999 for trafficked or 101

Any professional with concerns for a Missing, Exploited or Trafficked young person

Refer young person to CRT/MASH

Referral to MASH through CYP/Hants Direct

Missing	Exploited	Trafficked
Return home visit conducted by Police. PPN1 submitted with all relevant information. If child known to CSD - task NYAS/SW to complete home visit. If not known to CSD, task early help. For regular missing child (2 episodes in 90 days) referral to R&A for C&F assessment	Interview child where offences exist, with approved appropriate adult Safeguarding measures put in place. Risk management plan drawn up Barnardo's referral and SERAF form completed by referring agency. If SERAF scores high risk, instigate a Section 47 investigation	Screening interview with interpreter and approved appropriate adult Awareness of trafficking indicators, complete National Referral Mechanism Instigate a Section 47 investigation Refer immediately to UK Human Trafficking Centre and the Home Office for advice and support

Subject over 18
Refer to Salvation Army, local Adult Safeguarding and Barnardo's

Referral to Love 146 / Safe accommodation if trafficked
Start age assessment once accommodated

If not in safe accommodation refer to Barnardo's Trafficking service

Young person's details verified – age under 18

Monitor NYAS /Early help ongoing involvement Consider accommodation	Relevant support agency involved Consider accommodation	Relevant support agency involved Immediate safeguarding Merton Age assessment started Consider accommodation

Police flag the address and young person
