Board meeting held on 23 June 2016

KEY DECISIONS

- To establish a joint Executive for the Isle of Wight and Hampshire LSCBs, given the recommendation in the Wood review to remove the requirements for LSCBs. The joint Executive will assist when national legislation is proposed in response to the Wood review.
- To produce a joint Hampshire and Isle of Wight Business Plan for 2017-2018.
- To request a report be presented at the 22 September 2016 MET Sub Group meeting on transportation of children, which provides reassurance on the implementation of protocols and risk assessments for the transportation of SEN children using taxis.
- Responding to recommendations in the Child E Serious Case Review and the DLM Partnership Review, to consider a proposal for a Deep Dive Analysis to explore attitudes and beliefs in young people, carers and professionals, regarding the concepts of consent, sexual decision making and risk taking behaviour in young people on the Isle of Wight.
- To bring to the 15 December 2016 Board meeting a report produced by the P&QA Sub Group regarding how joint commissioning has responded to the need for therapeutic interventions and services to help ensure emotional resilience in children.
- To bring to the March 2017 Board meeting a report produced by the P&QA Sub Group regarding a Deep Dive Analysis of Elective Home Education on the Isle of Wight.
