The Isle of Wight Safeguarding Children Partnership (IOWSCP) and Domestic Abuse Partnership Board are delighted to announce the launch of our Safeguarding Practice Week for multi-agency professionals working with children and families on the Isle of Wight. The focus of this week is **‘Safeguarding Children who are Victims of Domestic Abuse’**.

This initiative aims to highlight the importance of safeguarding children who are impacted by domestic abuse. Each day of Safeguarding Practice Week, the IOWSCP will focus on multi-agency practice in a range of areas.

MONDAY: Introducing the Isle of Wight Domestic Abuse Referral Pathway.

The Domestic Abuse Referral Pathway for professionals:

- ◆ A comprehensive definition of domestic abuse
- ◆ Clarifies common terms like MARAC (Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference) and HRDA (High Risk Domestic Abuse meetings)
- ◆ Identifies the domestic abuse services available on the Isle of Wight
- ◆ Provides key contacts
- ◆ Provides a jargon buster and a flowchart to guide professionals when they receive a domestic abuse disclosure
